SHORT TERM RESIDENT “PERSONAL” NEEDS *(New Items Only)*

- Target, Walmart, Restaurant Gift Cards (for resident personal care items and resident use)
- iPod/iPad USB Wall Chargers
- Kids Socks, Undershirts for Men (S/M/L) and Kids (XL)
- Adult/Children’s Spin and Regular Toothbrushes (Soft)
- Cordless Electric Men’s and Women’s Razors
- Twin XL Size Sheets for Hospital Beds
- Hair Brushes and Hair Accessories
- Towels and Washcloths (Large Adult Size)
- Children & Teen Books on CD
- Men’s & Women’s Body Spray, Lotions, Flavored Chapsticks

LONG TERM ST. JOSEPH HOME COMMUNITY NEEDS

- Respite Guest Scholarship Program provides local families in need of Respite Care - \$250/overnight
- 12 Passenger Shuttle Bus used for Day Program, Community Exploration and Clinic Visit Transport - \$100,000
- Expansion of Therapy Hours; Physical, Occupational, Speech, Respiratory - \$250 supports 5 hours of therapy
- Blood Pressure Monitoring Equipment for each Resident Cottage - \$3000 per cottage
- Customized Stroller for a toddler aged resident who is wheelchair and ventilator dependent - \$5000 each
- Mobility Equipment to enhance socialization; EasyStand, Gait Trainer, Adaptive Tricycle at \$2000 to \$5000 each
- 2 Commercial Dryers that accommodate 300 lbs. of laundry per day - \$12,000 each
- Staff Training on inclusion with a “belonging toolkit” to support residents in community explorations - \$500
- Communication switches and buttons provide an alternative means to verbal communication - \$100 each
- A Sensory Garden and Solar Lighting for the Walking Path within the SJH Greenspace - \$100 to \$2500

VOLUNTEER NEEDS

- Individual Volunteers for Resident Programming; off campus explorations, reading to a resident, swimming assistance in the therapy pool, musicians, artists, front desk, data entry (weekly)
- Service Days and Seasonal Work; groups from churches, schools, corporations, clubs
- Committee Members to serve on St. Joseph Home Committees: Human Resources, Finance, Quality of Life, Development, Plant Operations, Fundraising Events (5K, Golf)
